Upon receipt by a school district of a completed Notice of Intent form, the school district shall provide the parent who filed the notification a written acknowledgement which clearly indicates that the parent has provided the notification required by law and that the child is exempt from compulsory attendance at the public school he is otherwise required to attend for the duration of the school year, or until the Board of Trustees determines that the child's exemption is no longer valid, whichever occurs first. This written acknowledgement shall be deemed proof of compliance with Nevada's compulsory attendance law.

The subjects, which are listed in NAC 392.035(1), may be taught as the parent determines is appropriate for the age and skill level of the child. Goals or materials need not comply with the standards of content and performance established for public schools, nor does every subject need to be taught every year.

The amount of instruction to be given is the equivalent of 180 days per NAC 392.035(4).
